



WSBBA QUICK RULES SUMMARY



- ▬ All ranks and styles of martial arts are welcome to participate in the WSBBA.
- ▬ WSBBA Membership is required to participate in any WSBBA event, and to be eligible for any WSBBA level, ranking, or record. A valid WSBBA Member ID Card is required for admittance to any WSBBA venue.
- ▬ It is the participant's responsibility to either bring his or her materials and supplies (excluding cinder block, which will be provided) to the event or make prior arrangements with the WSBBA at least three (3) weeks prior to the event.
- ▬ Competition will proceed in order by Level and Division as follows: Junior, Youth, Adult, and Senior. Awards will be given for each division by gender.
- ▬ For all WSBBA speed breaking levels, the standard brick is the 1" x 8" x 16" cement slab, supported by cinder block with no greater than 1/4" spacers between bricks, which can be square rod or carpenter pencils. Bricks will be weighed for total poundage using WSBBA-approved scales.
- ▬ Modification of bricks such as baking or drying is strictly prohibited and will result in automatic disqualification from the event.
- ▬ Judging of all WSBBA level or record attempts, as well as team competitions and individual heats, will be conducted by WSBBA-certified instructors (1st Dan or higher) using approved WSBBA stop-watches.
- ▬ Hand-wrapping is permitted with WSBBA-approved cloth.
- ▬ All bricks must be broken within the allotted time for the level or record, or for the heat to be finished.
- ▬ Competitors must start all heats from the same side (e.g. right to left), except in the case of a breakoff – see below.
- ▬ In the event of a tie, a breakoff between the tied competitors will be used. The lower ranked competitor will break first, and both competitors must begin from the side opposite their regular heat (i.e. if the competitor broke from left to right during his/her heat, he or she must break from right to left during the breakoff). If the competitors are of equal or equivalent rank, a coin toss will determine which competitor goes first.
- ▬ Members must complete an application, pay the appropriate fee, and be approved prior to a level or record attempt. This is separate from any additional non-WSBBA tournament or event fee.
- ▬ Setup and Cleanup: WSBBA officials will assist junior and youth competitors in setting up their bricks and removing broken bricks. Adult and senior competitors are solely responsible for setup and cleanup. Two minutes are allotted for cleanup.
- ▬ Beginning in 2007, annual standings in the WSBBA will be maintained during the calendar year using the following point system, per division and gender:

Place	WSBBA-Sanctioned Tournament Event	WSBBA Event
First	400 points	500 points
Second	200 points	300 points
Third	100 points	200 points
Level Attainment	100 points	100 points
Attendance	100 points	100 points
